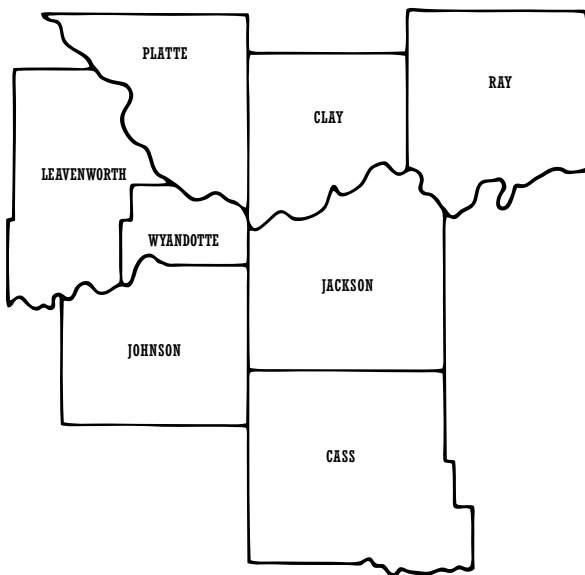

INTRODUCTION

The Metropolitan Emergency Resources Catalog (ERC) is published by the Plan Bulldozer Committee of The Heavy Constructors Association of the Greater Kansas City Area, and the Kansas City Chapter of the Associated General Contractors of America.

The purpose behind the ERC is found in the natural and man-made disasters that have occurred in Kansas City's past, which required the need for equipment and expertise from the area's construction companies to alleviate human suffering and loss of property. The ERC is intended to provide a convenient directory of available resources of services, supplies, and equipment for use during a disaster or other emergency.

The Plan Bulldozer Committee publishes an updated edition of the ERC annually. HOW TO USE THE EMERGENCY RESOURCES CATALOG

The Metropolitan Emergency Resources Catalog (ERC) has been organized to provide emergency officials and other public officials with the necessary information to handle a natural or man-made disaster.

The ERC details what constitutes a disaster, the issuance of an official disaster declaration by a responsible public official, and the implementation of "Plan Bulldozer." Services and equipment available in the Greater Kansas City Area are detailed for officials to assist them in their emergency efforts.

It is the intention of the Plan Bulldozer Committee that the resource procedures detailed in the ERC will assist the community in reducing the loss of lives and property during calamities.

PLAN BULLDOZER

DESCRIPTION OF PLAN BULLDOZER

Plan Bulldozer consists of numerous, separate agreements between participating contractors (see Participating Contractors in this section) and individual cities and counties in the Greater Kansas City Area to provide personnel and equipment during times of a disaster. These participating construction companies have agreed to provide assistance during the first 24 hours of a disaster or as long as circumstances exist in which public facilities are unable to stop further damage to human lives or property even though compensation cannot be guaranteed. Further assistance during the next 48 hours or as long as disaster operations are in operation, are provided at cost.

DISASTER DEFINED

A disaster is defined as extraordinary circumstances in which public facilities cannot arrest further injury to people or damage to property nor the reestablishment of an orderly physical environment. This includes, without limitation, man-made or natural calamitous events requiring mobilization of community resources to alleviate material damage, loss and human distress arising from such events such as attack by an enemy or similar hostile action, fire, explosion, flood, tornado, earthquake or any other catastrophic event.

DISASTER DECLARATION

Implementing the provisions of Plan Bulldozer requires the issuance of a Disaster Declaration by an appropriate public official of the affected community. A Disaster Declaration must be made by the Mayor or County Executive or his or her successor in descending order; the City/County Administrator, the Fire Chief or Deputy Fire Chief, the Chief of Police or Sheriff, the Disaster Preparedness Coordinator, etc.

INITIATING PLAN BULLDOZER ASSISTANCE

Upon issuance of a Disaster Declaration by the appropriate public official, notification must be made to Plan Bulldozer Headquarters or personnel in the following sequential order:
